Mission

Epitome of Soul, Inc. partners with community organizations to equip, empower, and encourage elementary and high school students to strive for academic excellence and cultural growth through the arts.

Each year, Epitome of Soul offers two scholarships to two deserving high school seniors. The Barbara Oslizly Memorial Scholarship and Keys of Success Scholarship for Performing Arts Students were created to support and encourage diligent students who have studied and have a growing interest in the arts. The ideal candidate for either scholarship award is a high school senior who meets the following requirements:

- Has demonstrated leadership ability through participation in community service and/or co-curricular activities
- Is a U.S. citizens or permanent resident
- Minimum of 20 hours of community service
- Has maintained a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Has received an acceptance letter from their intended college or university of study

Scholarship Award Process

- Final candidates will be selected six to eight weeks after the application deadline
- Scholarship recipients will be honored and must attend the Annual Epitome of Soul Holiday Gala. (If you are unable to attend, please notify the Scholarship committee)
- Scholarship monies will be awarded to students pending the following:
 1. Epitome of Soul receives an official copy of student's semester grades within 90 days of the completion of the semester
 2. Proof of enrollment for the fall semester
 3. A cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better was obtained. If a 3.0 GPA was not obtained, please contact the Scholarship Committee at info@epitomeofsoul.org. Additional information may be required to apply
 4. The number of awards given and the award amount may vary. Scholarships awards are for a maximum of \$1,000 USD
